KEN C. GREEN is a Chicagoan currently residing in Boston's Dorchester neighborhood. A former news reporter, sports reporter and editor, Ken began writing plays late in life, following a brief stint as a bad slam poet. He has had several plays performed at festivals, including the Fade to Black Play Festival in Houston. In addition to playwriting, Ken is a storyteller who helps run the Story Club Boston storytelling/reading show in Roslindale and has been featured on PBS' *Stories from the Stage* nationally televised storytelling program. He is a devoted Sox fan (White Sox, sorry). His plays include *Just Listen...* (Boston Theater Marathon, 2020), *The Campaign* (Marblehead Little Theater 2020 [postponed], Boston Theater Marathon, 2019; Fade to Black Play Festival 2018), *Filling in the Gaps* (Firehose Center for the Arts' New Works Festival 2020 [postponed]), *16 Inch* (Company One staged reading, 2016), and *The Line and State* (Fade to Black play festival, 2019 and 2015).



MICHAEL OFORI returns to New Repertory Theatre after last being seen in *Cardboard Piano*. Other recent credits include *The Journey* (Ahab), *Much Ado About Nothing* (Leonato), *Blue Orange* (Christopher), and *Through a Film Darkly* (Addo). Michael holds a BFA in Theater from the University of Ghana; and MA in African Studies from Ohio University; and an MFA in Theater Education from Boston University. He currently teaches theater at Mount Holyoke College. Originally from Ghana, Michael now resides in Chicopee, MA.

Overseeing visual and fashion merchandising for companies such as Aldo, Express, Victoria Secret, and Target; Kiara expanded her expertise by providing her creative services to theatrical productions. 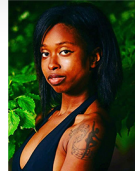
KADAHJ BENNETT is psyched to make his New Rep debut in on such a timely piece of Boston
