Live Virtual Post-show Discussions: Week of March 15, 2021 (all virtual)

Performance will be recorded and shared via private link to audiences. Actors are asked to be available the week of March 15, for live, virtual post-show discussions with school groups who request this.

COVID SAFETY: For the protection of our artistic and production teams, this project will be a combination of virtual and in-person rehearsals and recording sessions. All in-person sessions will follow strict COVID guidelines including access to testing and PPE (personal protective equipment), limiting capacity, pre-rehearsal health survey and more to ensure safety of all.
